

#### How the silent auction works

When you checked in you were given a bid number that you will use throughout the evening. When you find an item you love, BID ON IT! There is a bidding sheet with each item. Write your bid number on the sheet and the amount you are bidding. Please note the opening bid amount and the required increments listed on the sheet and follow this.

#### Check back frequently! Keep on bidding!

Listen for announcements indicating a table is closing – that is the warning that you have a final opportunity to be a high bidder. Check on your item(s)! Once a table has closed, circle back to confirm on which items you were the lucky high bidder. When you are ready to pick up and pay for your item(s), go to the check-out area and proceed to the correct line (cash and checks or credit). Inform the friendly check-out volunteer what your bidder number is, and s/he will retrieve all the slips that went with the items on which you were the lucky high bidder. After paying you may return to the auction tables, show your bidder number to one of the auction volunteers and retrieve your items (except for all gift certificates which will be given to high bidders at the check-out area when paying). Thank you!

Bid often and generously and have fun! Proceeds from tonight's auction support the building of homes with qualifying low income families in Hampshire and Franklin Counties.


